To whom it may concern,

Kindly be advised that, pursuant to the laws and statutes of the State of New Jersey, New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) is an institution of higher education that is licensed and authorized by the State to offer baccalaureate degrees, master's degrees, graduate certificates, and doctoral degrees.

In addition, kindly be advised that approval from this office is no longer required for a New Jersey-based institution of higher education to establish either a branch campus or an additional instructional site located in New Jersey. On December 21, 2015, the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education promulgated amended licensure rules at N.J.A.C. 9A:1-1 et seq., which eliminated the previous requirement for New Jersey-based institutions of higher education to obtain approval from this office to establish branch campuses and certain additional instructional sites located in New Jersey.

This letter stands in place of a formal state certified license because New Jersey does not issue a formal license to authorize the operation of institutions of higher education within the State.
