

Academic Policy for Students with Revoked Visas

Purpose and Scope

This document outlines the academic policy for students with revoked visas for the New Jersey Institute of Technology. NJIT is committed to ensuring that all students in good academic standing and who are otherwise eligible can complete their required work for courses for which they are registered. Faculty and staff are expected to provide reasonable accommodations to allow for the continuation and completion of academic requirements.

Procedures and Guidelines

Notification

Any student who becomes aware of a visa revocation should immediately notify the Office of Global Initiatives (OGI). OGI will verify the students' status and eligibility.

Academic Accommodations

Instructors are expected to offer opportunities to participate remotely (either asynchronous or synchronous), flexible deadlines, and alternative assignments to accommodate impacted students. Instructors should maintain regular communication with affected students to monitor progress and address challenges. NJIT will provide instructors with guidance and assistance with necessary technological resources. In cases where individual instructors encounter challenges in providing appropriate academic accommodations, instructors should consult with their Department Chair and Dean for guidance and assistance with alternative accommodations.

Review and Policy Amendments

This policy is in effect from April 12, 2025, until further notice. This policy is subject to ongoing review and may be amended or revoked in response to evolving circumstances and guidance from federal and state authorities. By adopting this policy, NJIT aims to demonstrate continued support for our international student community and their academic progress.
