### Prerequisites and Language Requirements:

- **60 ECTS credits** Undergraduate/bachelor courses. See syllabi for specifications.
- **Fluency in English:** The home university guarantees a student's fluency in English. Read more about the language requirements here: [language requirements](#).

### Tuition fees and costs

- Tuition fee: **Tuition waived** for agreed number of students from partner university (regular fee: 25000 SEK)
- Application fee: **Application fee waived** for agreed number of students from partner university (regular fee: 900 SEK)
- Accommodation: Between 3500 – 5000 SEK per month
- Social and Cultural package: 2500 SEK. The package includes the following: company visits, welcome lunch, farewell dinner, certificate ceremony, and social and cultural activities such as a trip to one of Sweden's best-preserved castles from the 16th century in Vadstena, a trip to Gränna; a charming city where traditional Swedish peppermint candy canes are handmade, a visit to the ruins of Brahehus Castle, after-school activities, a Swedish Midsummer celebration and much more!



## Nomination:

You need to nominate your students in Mobility Online through a nomination link. The nomination link will be sent once the application is open. By submitting the nominations, your students will receive a personal link in their email to fill in their application and provide us all necessary information in Mobility Online.

## Deadlines:

Nomination by partner: **March 15**

Student Application: **April 1**

## Accommodation

Students will have access to accommodation organized by JU. The students will receive more information about the accommodation after they have been admitted to the Summer School.

## Cancellation policy:

Cancellations made after 1 May: students may need to pay a cancellation fee for the accommodation, this is up to each landlord to decide.

## Entry requirements to Sweden

Please note that citizens of certain countries do not require a visa to enter Sweden if staying shorter than 3 months. See the [list of countries that require a visa for entry into Sweden](#) or contact the Swedish Embassy or consulate in the home country for more information.

## Insurances

The students are covered by Personal Injury Insurance for students. The insurance applies in Sweden and covers injuries during school hours and during travel to and from the location where school hours are spent.
